

Reopening Guidance for Senior Centers and Adult Day Care

Issued: June 25, 2021

The Aging and Long-Term Services Department has developed the following reopening guidance for use in senior centers and adult day care providers across the state. This document is guidance and outline the minimum procedures or processes centers should employ when reopening. All senior centers and adult care providers should follow and routinely monitor COVID-19 Safe Practices for businesses. Centers should review this document and New Mexico's covid safe practice and carefully develop their own processes incorporating the guidance below. Your processes do not need to be submitted for approval but must be kept on premise and made available in the case of an inspection, outbreak, or audit.
